Tony Alter/Flickr A baby snake is called a snakelet. A snake that comes from an egg can also be called a hatchling, while the young of snakes that give live birth can also be called neonates. There are more than 3,000 species of snake in the world, and snakes live on every continent except Antarctica.Snake Eggs Around 70 percent of snake species are oviparous, meaning they lay eggs with shells. Snake eggs are leathery rather than hard and are usually left in a dark, warm, and damp place. While many snake species immediately abandon their eggs, others guard them against predators and use their body heat for incubation. Examples of oviparous snakes include kingsnakes, rat snakes, grass snakes, mambas, adders, and cobras. The king cobra is unique in that it builds a nest for its eggs and may stay to guard them even after they have hatched. Many kinds of boa protect their eggs until they hatch as well. Snake Birth Other snakes are viviparous, meaning they give birth to live young. To give birth this way is very rare in reptiles. These snakes develop with a placenta (a soft membrane) and yolk sack to nourish them while they are young. The advantage to this approach is that the snakes stay inside the mother's body until they can survive colder temperatures on their own. Boa constrictors and green anacondas are examples of viviparous snakes. A Third Kind of Snake Some snakes are a cross between viviparous and oviparous. While they have eggs, the shells do not become tough and solid, and the mother doesn't lay them anywhere. Instead, she keeps the eggs inside herself until they hatch, at which point the young leave her body. These snakes are ovoviviparous. A common example of this kind of snake is the rattlesnake. As with snakes that give live birth, ovoviviparous snakes tend to abandon their young immediately. This is why even baby rattlesnakes are venomous — they need to protect themselves from day one. Venomous Snakelets You may have heard that venomous snakelets are more dangerous than the adults, either because they are unable to control how much venom they inject or because their venom is more potent. Luckily, this isn't true. Because snakelets are so much smaller than adult snakes, their venom sacs contain much less venom. Even if a baby snake were to release all its venom at once, it would still be a much lower dose than an adult would use. Studies show that bigger snakes cause worse snakebites with more venom. There's also no evidence that adult snakes are more likely to choose not to inject venom during a bite compared to snakelets. Snake Growth Once they are outside their shell or mother's body, all snakes adapt to the world quickly. Venomous snakes are born ready to use their venom, and baby rattlesnakes already have their first button on their rattle. They begin to hunt their own food immediately, and most species can have snakelets of their own two years after birth. Larger species may take as long as four or five years to reach sexual maturity. While snakes tend to grow more slowly once they reach that point, they continue to grow at a lesser rate for the rest of their lives. A male is a buckling. At a year old, a female goat is a doe or nanny. An adult male goat is referred to as a billy or buck. The formal name for a group of goats is a herd, although some people use the term tribe. As with all living creatures, there are a lot of factors to keep in mind to ensure a baby goat is healthy and happy in its surroundings. Let's explore some of the care that is required for raising a goat.Assisting with Birth A doe has the ability to become pregnant as soon as it reaches puberty. This can be as young as four months old. However, veterinary experts suggest waiting until the goat is 10 to 15 months old before breeding them. A typical gestation for pregnancy is 150 days. This allows the doe to reach 15 to 20 months old before giving birth, making the process easier. During pregnancy it's important for the doe to receive proper nutrition and a safe, comfortable place to reside. Ensure that fresh straw, food and plenty of water is provided during this time. When birthing begins, the doe has natural instincts that allow her to give birth on her own in normal circumstances. Should you notice her struggling, you can provide assistance. You may be required to gently pull on the baby as it's being born. Maintain a firm, yet gentle grip on the kid. Swaddle the kid in a clean, warm blanket. Gently rock the swaddled baby back and forth to help loosen any mucus or secretions that remain in its airways. The doe will take over quickly to clean her baby. Ensuring Proper Nutrition When the kid is born, it'll begin nursing within the first 30 to 45 minutes. However, this may take a little longer. Don't panic. If the baby doesn't take to the mother as needed, you can provide nutrition through bottle feeding. It's important to ensure the baby receives colostrum within the first few hours of its birth. This milk contains antibodies that help fight off infections and illnesses while building a strong immune system. This supplement is provided through the doe's milk naturally. However, if you need to bottle feed the kid, you should have the colostrum supplement around. You can switch to regular replacement milk after the first few days. A kid needs to be fed at least four times throughout a day. Weaning A kid can be weaned from the mother after 30 days. However, you should aim for six to eight weeks after birth. To provide for the fiber necessary in a goat's diet, introduce hay after the second week. Other types of fiber supplements include grain and grass. Shelter A baby goat is susceptible to different types of diseases and illnesses because its immune system has not reached full maturity. Ensure it has adequate shelter to sleep and play in. The shelter should be warm and dry, away from winds or drafts from the outside. Clean straw or wood chips should be used for the flooring for the kid to sleep on. There should be plenty of room to accommodate however many babies are present. As long as the mother and baby are doing fine, it's not necessary to seek immediate vet care. However, you should make arrangements for a check-up when possible to give your new addition the best start in life. Your vet may suggest nutritional supplements, exercise or vaccinations. The male is called a bull, and the female is called a cow. A group of elephants is usually called a herd. Elephants have one of the most intricate social structures of any species on Earth. Female elephants don't usually give birth until they are about 15 years old. Meanwhile, males aren't ready to reproduce until they reach the age of about 30. Once females mature and become mothers, they may have up to 12 calves in their lifetimes, usually waiting a year after birth to become pregnant again. The gestation period for an elephant is 22 months. Elephant Reproduction Birth of a Baby Elephant When the female cow is ready to give birth, she'll stay close to other trusted females in her herd to receive protection when she does finally go into labor. Birth is quick, and elephants almost always have just one baby. The average calf is about 3 feet tall and weighs around 120 pounds. The calf's mother and other elephants in the herd help it to its feet, and it's able to stand on its own within 2 hours of birth. At birth, the calf is hairy with a long tail and short trunk. Baby Elephant's First 2 Years Elephants don't mature as quickly as many other animals do, and they typically don't wean themselves from their mother's milk until they are about two years old. A few days after birth, the calf is strong enough to walk and keep up its herd, although the females in the herd may slow their pace to help any new babies keep up with them. During those early months, the calf's mother and the other females in the herd guide it, teaching it which plants are OK to eat and how to stay safe from predators. After six months, the calf begins eating vegetation in addition to its mother's milk. Adult Elephants Adult elephants are the largest land mammal on Earth. They can grow to be up to 13 feet at the shoulders and more than 14,000 pounds. They can live up to 70 years. Female-dominated Herds and an Elephant's Social Life Having family and friends around as part of the herd is important to the elephant's life. They live in female-dominant herds, often casting out males who go off to live alone or in smaller groups. The herd's oldest female is usually its leader. Her job is to help with socialization, survival, and finding food and water. Herds typically consist of up to 20 elephants. Elephants are said to be kind and intelligent, and they greet each other with their trunks. They can identify a friendly elephant up to 2 miles away through low sounds and rumbles. Other traits elephants show that aren't always common in the animal kingdom are problem-solving, mourning, and empathy. Types of Elephants While there are several subspecies of elephants, there are only two species. African elephants tend to be larger and live longer. As the name suggests, they live primarily in about 37 African countries. Asian elephants are smaller and have a slightly shorter lifespan. They live in at least 13 Asian countries. Elephants' HabitatsAsian elephants typically live in the continent's forests and rainforests. African elephants live throughout sub-Saharan Africa.
